




The 6 month follow up

- This is when the most important data for the study is collected
- We will arrange a special blood pressure monitor to be sent to your home
- · You will need to wear this for one full day (and night), then post it back to us
- · Without this data, we won't find out if selfmanagement of blood pressure after birth works or is beneficial for people like you

There is a new form in the main database to record your follow up call attempts at 6, 12, 26 and 52 weeks.

After you have made and recorded 3 call attempts, the central trial team will automatically email and/or text the forms to the participant to self-complete.






Please remind the participant to post their urine sample if they remain on medication at their 6 week follow up visit! Leave this blank on the database if they have not sent their sample yet.





At recruitment, explain ABPM and the importance of completing this in 6 months time. Try and complete their 6 month follow up 2-4 weeks before expected date, to remind the participant about ABPM and that the trial team will contact them to arrange the ABPM.
